The Adams County/Ohio Valley School District Board of Education is seeking qualified applicants for the position of Superintendent. The current Superintendent, Charles P. Kimble, is retiring effective July 31, 2010, after serving 8 years in that capacity for the district. The board is being assisted in its search by the Southern Ohio Educational Service Center.

THE SCHOOL DISTRICT

The Adams County/Ohio Valley School District was created in 1970 after the consolidation of Adams County's four local school districts into one. The present district encompasses 487 square miles, being the second largest geographical school district in the State of Ohio. The district includes seven school buildings—three high schools, a career and technical center, and three elementary schools—along with an Administration Office and bus garage. The construction of four new high school buildings and renovation of the previous facilities was completed in 1997. A bond issue was passed in 2006 to build three new elementary schools and renovate the existing high schools and CTC. The new elementary buildings were opened to students in January 2010.

Special programs for handicapped, preschool, all-day every-day kindergarten, extended enrichment program, reading recovery, and writing processes are in place. A vital element of the secondary program is the career and technical center that attracts approximately thirty percent of the juniors and seniors.

THE SCHOOL COMMUNITY

The Adams County/Ohio Valley School District is located in the heart of Ohio's Appalachian country.
