Search our catalog for a word or phrase by filling in the search box and clicking on *Go*. Use the Media and Grade Level filters to search only those collections.

Notes on searching:

- o An * at the end of a word will match all endings. Example, CAT* will match CAT, CATS and CATCH.
- o A ? at the end of a word will match any character. Example, CAT? will match CAT or CATS, but not CATCH.
- o Catalog entries that have one or more matches will be displayed. For more control over the search, use the advanced search.
- o The media types and grade levels are filters. Only after the searching is completed will the filters be applied. If no grade levels or media types are selected, all of the found records displayed.
- o You can enter a list of title numbers separated by commas in place of a title. Example: **VH1234, 25-1234, 23456**

Click *Go* to display the titles that match your criteria. If you just want the system to pick some titles at random leave the search fields blank and click Search. If you'd like to browse titles in alphabetical order just click on *Browse* on the menu.

Pages available from the function menu:

- o Browse - Scan the catalog in alphabetic order.
- o Order Form - Schedule items for delivery to your building.
- o On Order - View the material that has been shipped or is scheduled for shipment to your building.
- o Past Orders - View the material that you've ordered or used in the past.
- o Password - Change your account password.
- o Help - View the context sensitive help at the bottom of each form.
- o Close - Sign off Web/MAX and return to our home page.
- o Contact Us - Send an email to our staff.

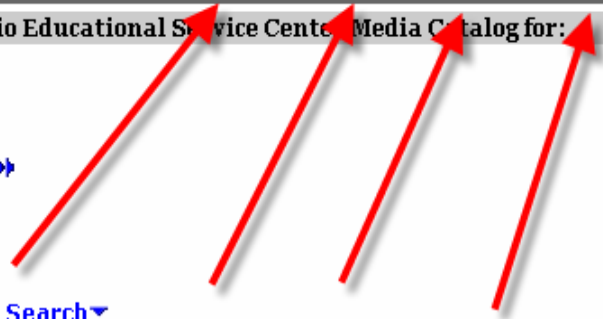
