






Day 1: Sensory Processing: Implications for Behavior & Learning

To be able to successfully support young children with ASD, it is important to understand the characteristics of Autism Spectrum Disorder in order to support their development. Interventions, strategies, and supports will also be shared to support underlying characteristics of ASD. Participants will gain an understanding of sensory processing challenges and the impact it can have on the child's ability to play, learn and participate in activities. Participants will learn environmental modifications and intervention strategies to support sensory challenges.

Day 2: Communication

Communication is the foundation for all learning and interactions. This session will focus on how to develop and implement communication supports including assistive technology.

Day 3: Social-Emotional Competence, Play & Friendship Skills

Being able to develop the ability to interact socially can be one of the most challenging aspects of life for individuals with ASD. This session will introduce how to acquire and build social competence skills for young children with ASD, and how to implement interventions that can help develop social competence, play and friendships.


