

We were lucky enough to have the Ohio Outreach Center for Deafness and Blindness visit us at Hopewell Center Ohio Region 14 in 2018 - 2019 school year. They also visited with us at other locations such as a few schools within our region. **Promoting Access** is a free online module that is 2.5 hours long focusing on promoting access for individuals that are Deaf and/or Blind. Once the module is completed then a certificate is generated and everyone is encouraged to complete the training.
