  - HB498 expulsion of a student from a school district, community school or STEM school for communicating a threat of violence to occur on school grounds.
  - SB297 expulsion of a student from a school district, community school or STEM school for communicating a threat of violence to occur on school grounds.
  - o Kids PAC established by the OSBA Executive Committee to give board members the opportunity to belong to a PAC (Political Action Committee) whose membership was aware of the problems facing boards of education and whose goals are aimed at dealing with those issues.
