Take the first steps towards becoming a certified Google Level 1 Educator or prepare to be an authorized Google Education Trainer, or simply improve your Google knowledge and skills.

SOESC is offering 2-day Google Level II Camps at SOESC Wilmington Office, 3321 Airborne Rd., Wilmington, Ohio 45177. These trainings will include in-depth Google topics such as Chrome Extensions and Add Ons, Map Tools, Hangouts, YouTube, Documents, Sheets, Forms, Slides, Drawings, Blogger, and more.

The content of these trainings is designed to prepare participants for the official Google Educator Level 2 exam. The Level 2 certification is for super-users and enthusiasts for Google tools in the classroom. For those who want to go further, this training is also the next step to help prepare participants to apply to become an authorized Google Education Trainer. Please note participants are responsible for passing the Google exams and completing the application process, which includes associated fees outside of this training.

### → COST:

- The non-refundable cost for each 2-day session is \$100 for participants within the SOESC consortium, or \$150 for participants outside of the SOESC consortium.
- This cost does not include the fee for the Google certification exams. Those who wish to become a certified Google Educator will need to take the Level 1 exam for \$10 and the Level 2 exam for \$25. SOESC can not guarantee approval by Google.
- This cost does not include lunch. There will be a one hour lunch break each day.
