



# Ohio Resident Educator Program Mentor Academy Training

Mentor Academy is a two-day workshop required for **new** Mentors to become state-certified and eligible to mentor Resident Educators. The Ohio Department of Education updated the training materials and activities for the 2018 Mentor Academy this winter to address changes in the Resident Educator Program, including the new Focused Mentoring requirement. The updated 2018 Mentor Academy includes topics such as: Formative and Summative Assessment, Actionable Feedback, Beginning Teacher Needs, Professional Conversations and detailed training on implementing the Teaching and Learning Cycle. New Mentors attending the Mentor Academy will have more opportunities to enjoy professional conversations with peers and learn how to plan and provide feedback to their Resident Educators.
